The principal objective of our Safety Policy and Management System is to:


- To achieve an accident free, healthy and safe working environment for any person associated with the site.

- 3) Ensure WHS considerations are included in all planning and work processes
- 4) Consult with site personnel on a regular basis with regard to Safety issues and ensure that open and honest communication exists between management and employees at all levels in the organisation
- 5) Provide appropriate training, especially induction and Safe Working Method familiarisation
- 6) Ensure all personnel are qualified and capable of conducting their tasks in a safe manner
- 7) Identify, assess, eliminate or control all potential hazards in the workplace through proactive attention to regular risk assessments and site safety inspections.
- 8) Provide effective injury management should site personnel return to work following illness or injury
- 9) Ensure all plant and equipment at the site is safe and fit for purpose
- 10) Maintain appropriate records
- 11) Achieve continuous improvement through review of performance statistics and comparing these to measurable WHS performance objectives
